## Care and Safety

If you have any concerns or worries about your child's education, or care and safety in school please speak to your child's class teacher initially, or see our Deputy Headteacher Mrs Wheatcroft, if Mrs White is unavailable at a particular point in time.

Staff are available in classrooms if a quick chat will ease a concern. However, please be aware that staff are responsible for children from 8.40am. After this time, pupils begin to enter school, so we ask that you please arrange for an appointment to speak to the class teacher through the office, or by speaking to a member of staff in the corridors.

Messages will be passed on - Staff will always call you back as soon as they are able to do so. Any concerns / queries, however small, are always better discussed so issues don't escalate.
