Dear Parents/Carers,

From September 2017, we are considering introducing the idea of something similar to what you can see on this 'play pods' video, onto our playground. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nqi1KyJJeKq

I strongly believe that activities centred around creative play like these, help to develop children's skills in all areas of the curriculum. It builds on our teaching of the 5R's (Developing Resilience, Responsibility, being Resourceful and Reflective and builds up Reasoning skills, which help pupils learn how to manage safe risks.

I have spoken to the midday meals supervisors, staff and children about this concept and pupils are very enthusiastic, saying that we can do it for FREE, by recycling things parents may be able to get for us.

The children felt that the idea of play through S.K.I.P. (Safe 'K'reative Imaginative Play) would help them in so many ways like ...

- "It gets everyone involved."
- "It lets everyone have chance to do what they like to do."
- "It's fun."
- "helps us make things"
- "Be Good for recycling."
- "Improve DT skills."
- "Lots of trial and error."
- "Gives us challenges."
- "Helps us work together as a team."
- "May make some new friends."

Some very important skills are learnt through this concept. Life skills - of learning to fail, how to improve and have determination to succeed through trial and error.
